For example: one child in grade 4 and one in grade 2 would cost \$855 plus \$445 = \$1,300 for their first year in our school (discounted from other years).

Please Consider the Benefits of Membership at Temple B'nai Israel:

You must be a Temple B'nai Israel Family Member in the year that your child has a Bar/Bat Mitzvah here. You are not required to have a membership at Temple B'nai Israel to attend the Religious School and you are not required to have a membership in years prior to a Bar/Bat Mitzvah year. However, each year that you maintain a Family Membership at Temple B'nai Israel you receive several benefits:

- Setting a role model for children by active participation in and support of the temple
- Significantly lower school tuition
- \$600 credit per child per year enrolled in our school toward the \$3,000 Bar/Bat Mitzvah fee (after five years in our school – as members – the entire Bar/Bat Mitzvah fee is paid)
- Greater access to our rabbi
- Greater access to our membership
- Opportunities to participate on various temple committees and greater ability to help direct and plan the education of your children
- Lifecycle event planning for weddings, anniversaries, funerals, Bar/Bat mitzvahs
- Increased opportunities for participation and honors at services
- Discounts at various temple events and educational programs
- High Holiday tickets
- Temple Scribe mailings and weekly communications
- Gift shop discounts on selected merchandise
- Greater opportunities for recognition within our Jewish community

No family was ever turned away from Temple B'nai Israel on the basis of inability to pay our membership, building fund, or school fees. If you think you cannot afford to join Temple B'nai Israel for reasons of financial hardship, please consider speaking to either Judge Edmond Bart (630) 892-3822 or Dr. Phil Jacobson (630) 897-3114, who will keep any conversation with you completely confidential, and who can set up a special dues consideration for your family with the temple secretary for billing purposes. Other than these three individuals, no other temple officers, directors, members, or school staff has any knowledge about financial hardships.

If you try our school as a non-member family, and like what you see before the last day of school (usually the first week in June), please consider converting to a membership, obtaining a rebate of school fees, and applying this rebate toward your membership dues. Of course, you will also be provided a credit toward our normal Bar/Bat Mitzvah fee.
